Locating the Tool & Running the SOE Report

1. In the top Navigation menu, in the Spatial Overlay section of the toolbar find the SOE Report icon. Select the icon to launch the SOE tool.



2. You can query by point, line, polygon and rectangle. First select a point, select a location on the map and click next.
