Identifying Features

On the 'Home' tab, click on the Identify tool to search the layers on the map to determine a list of features and provide additional information on specific features.

Instead of using the Search box to generate results, an identity area is defined on the map by drawing a shape.

Before you draw your shape, you can:

- click Enable buffering to add a buffer of any distance to select identified features from

- click Identifiable Layers to choose which layers to identify features from



The identify results will be displayed in the Results List window in the Information Panel
