Launching the CAD Public Map Service in iMapBC

- 1. The CAD Public Map Service is a theme within the public version of iMapBC. iMapBC can be accessed at the GoeBC Gateway: <u>http://geobc.gov.bc.ca/</u>
- 2. Click on the *Applications* link



3. Navigate down the list of applications to the **First Nations Consultation Areas Database (CAD)** section and select the *Launch Public Application* link.

The First Nations Consultative Areas Database (CAD) provides preliminary contact information for First Nations who may have Aboriginal Interests identified within the area queried. These contacts are based on knowledge currently available to the Province.

Locating the Tools & Running the CAD Report

1. The CAD tool has been bundled into the CAD Report and is located in the Reports menu tab. To launch the cad tool, first select the *Reports* menu tab.





- 2. Next, select the **Report** CAD Report icon in the Spatial Overlay section of the toolbar.
- 3. You can select by point, line, polygon and rectangle. Select a point, select a location on the map and click next.



4. Next, select your desired buffer (m) and report name and select submit.
